1. Proposal

2. Learning Objectives

Provide a description of the learning objectives. The learning objectives should detail what you think you'll better understand at the end of the Supervised Research that you didn't know, or couldn't do, before. Be specific.

3. Methods of Investigation

Explain the technical approaches and strategies you will take to meet the learning objectives and deliverables. Examples: reference searches, experimentation, prototype builds, data collection, statistical analysis, etc. Provide initial reference materials that you plan to use as part of the SR. A complete list of references must be provided at the conclusion of the SR.

4. Deliverables

Summarize the <u>deliverable artifacts</u>. Examples: research paper, summary report or documentation, prototype hardware and/or software, tool or application development, extension or enhancement, architectural design, formal presentation, or some combination of these artifacts. Please include a complete list of references.

5. Schedule of Milestones

Provide a general plan and <u>schedule of the key milestones and deliverables</u>. The date of final deliverable(s) submission must be included in the schedule. (Important: Final deliverable(s) must be received no later than the semester deadline for grade submission).

Please attach a separate document that includes all of these elements.
